Subject: Call for Nominations to Serve on the ABNM

The American Board of Nuclear Medicine (ABNM) is calling for nominations of ABNM certified physicians to replace directors whose terms will end in July 2026. The nominees should be currently licensed and actively practicing nuclear medicine in the United States of America or Canada. They should be certified by the ABNM and participate actively in the ABNM Continuing Certification program.

The ABNM seeks individuals with varied experiences, perspectives, and backgrounds to include members of underrepresented groups. Nominations of diplomates in all career phases and practice settings are encouraged. The ABNM is particularly interested in nominees with expertise in Neurology, Cardiology, and Renal, although all areas of expertise will be considered. Diplomates are encouraged to self-nominate.

Nominees must be available to attend, in person, the ABNM 115th Board Meeting, July 6th through July 8th, 2026, in Manchester, Vermont.

Nominees should believe in and support the mission and strategic goals of the ABNM and have enough time to fulfill the duties and responsibilities outlined below.

Desired competencies:

- Expertise in practice areas listed above
- Ability to write required high-quality examination questions
- Nuclear medicine education of trainees
- Professional leadership

Physicians may nominate themselves or another ABNM diplomate. Nominees should not have any conflicts of interest described on the [ABNM Conflict of Interest Statement](#).

Directors serve three years, usually with reappointment for an additional three years. New directors will be required to take the Continuing Certification exam in October, following their appointment.

Nomination Process:

Individuals nominating another ABNM diplomate should submit a supporting letter, and ask the diplomate to submit a statement of interest and qualifications and complete the [Nomination Form](#).

Individuals who nominate themselves should submit a statement of interests and qualifications and complete the [Nomination Form](#).

Letters of recommendation from other individuals are optional but encouraged.
